Building Design –

Discussion was held on looking at doing the building in 2 phases. Phase 1 would be a 40' x 270' building for swine, sheep, goats, dairy animals

Phase 2 would be an 80' x 150' structure that would cover the showing and spectator area. This would be extend to the existing wash rack and the wash rack would be used for drainage.
