



Public presentations can relate to any of the project areas and can fit into one of the following four categories.

Demonstrations:

speeches that give the step-by-step processes and result in a finished product (such as how to play a song on the guitar, or how to make a PB&J).

Public Speaking: a more formal speech in which the member educates the audience on a project, program, or idea.

Illustrated Talks:

speeches that are a combination of speaking and showing utilizing at least one visual aid (poster, PowerPoint, a saddle, etc.).

Project “Why”: an exhibit is prepared, and the member explains “why” and answers questions for a moving audience. Like a science fair display

Public presentations are prepared and presented by the 4-H member. 4-H’ers are welcome and encouraged to talk to the 4-H office for the public presentation handbook, score sheets, and assistance preparing a public presentation. A grand champion and reserve champion in each age division will be awarded to the overall top public presentations at Youth in Action Day in spring.
